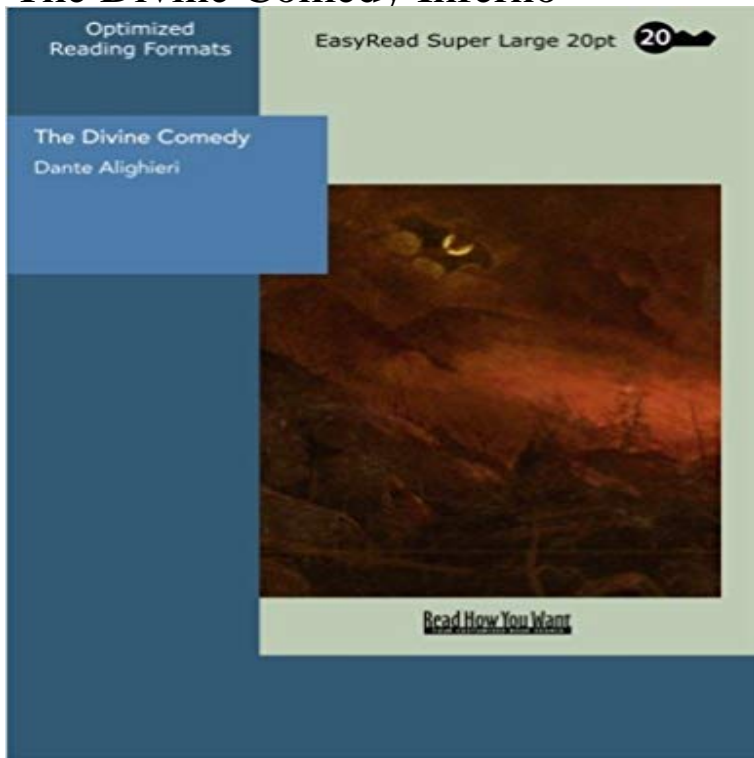


# The Divine Comedy Inferno
