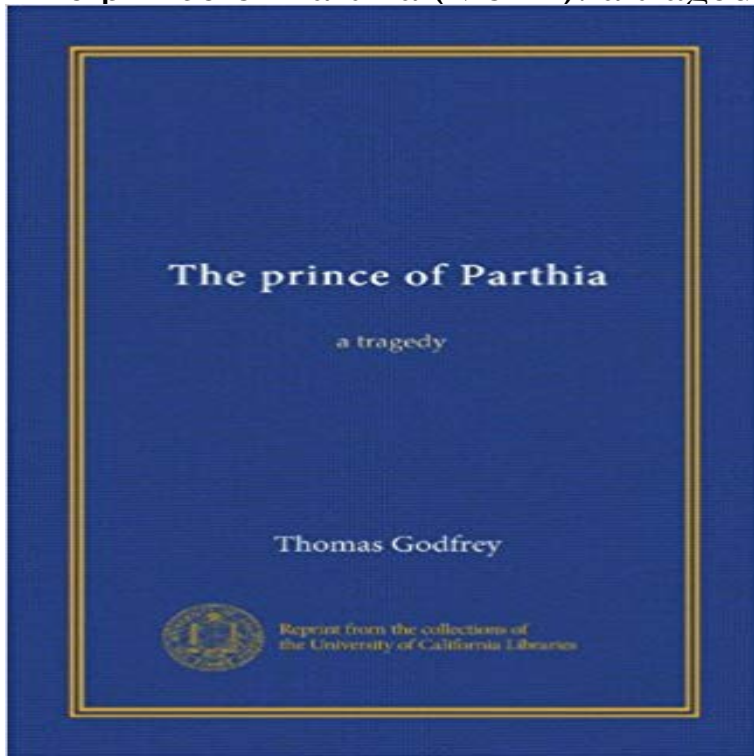


The prince of Parthia (Vol-1): a tragedy
