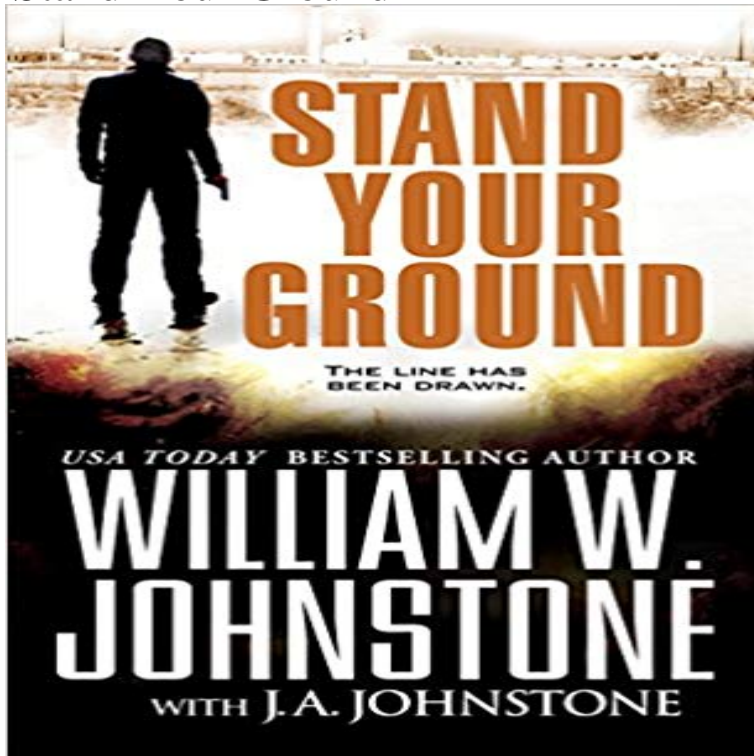


Stand Your Ground
