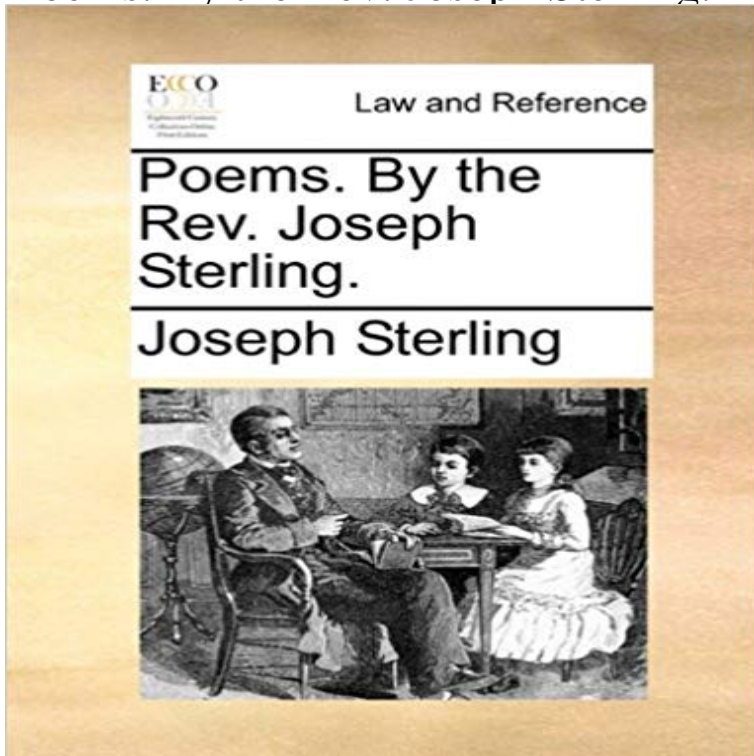


Poems. By the Rev. Joseph Sterling.
