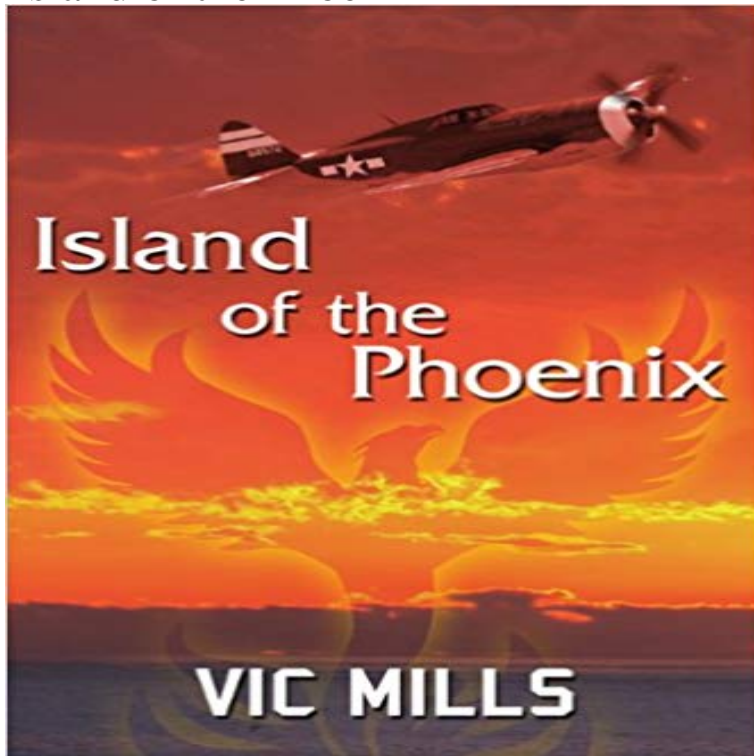


Island of the Phoenix
