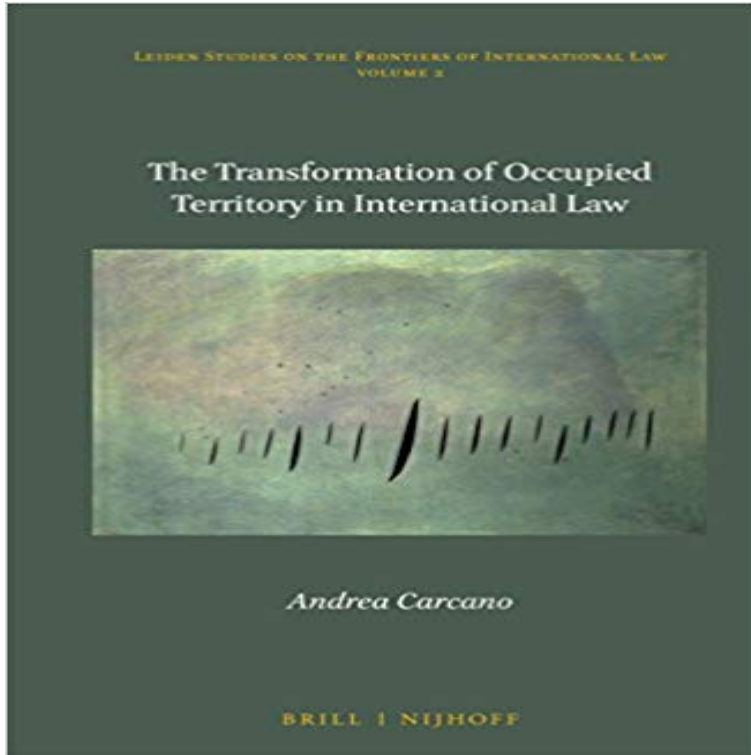


The Transformation of Occupied Territory in International Law (Leiden Studies on the Frontiers of International Law)
