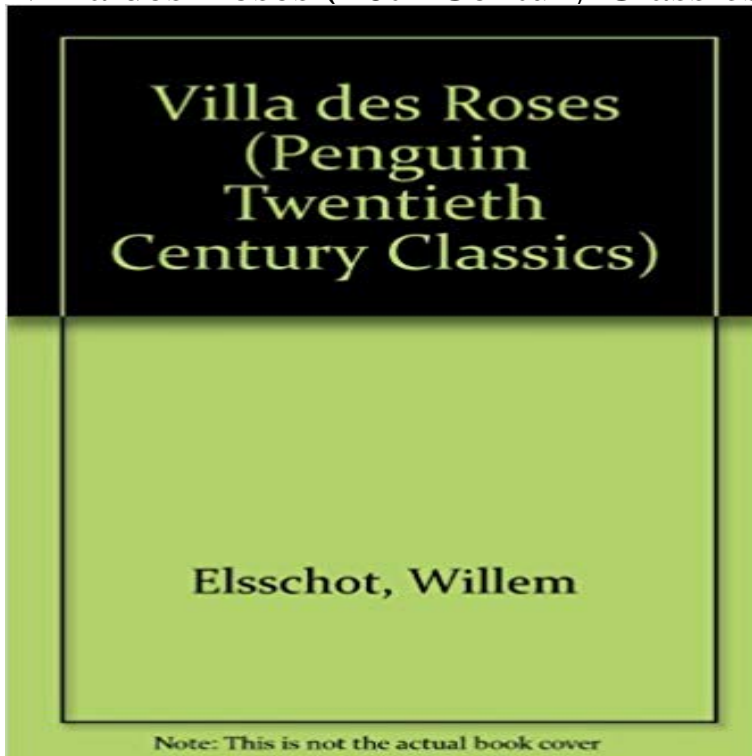


Villa des Roses (20th Century Classics)
